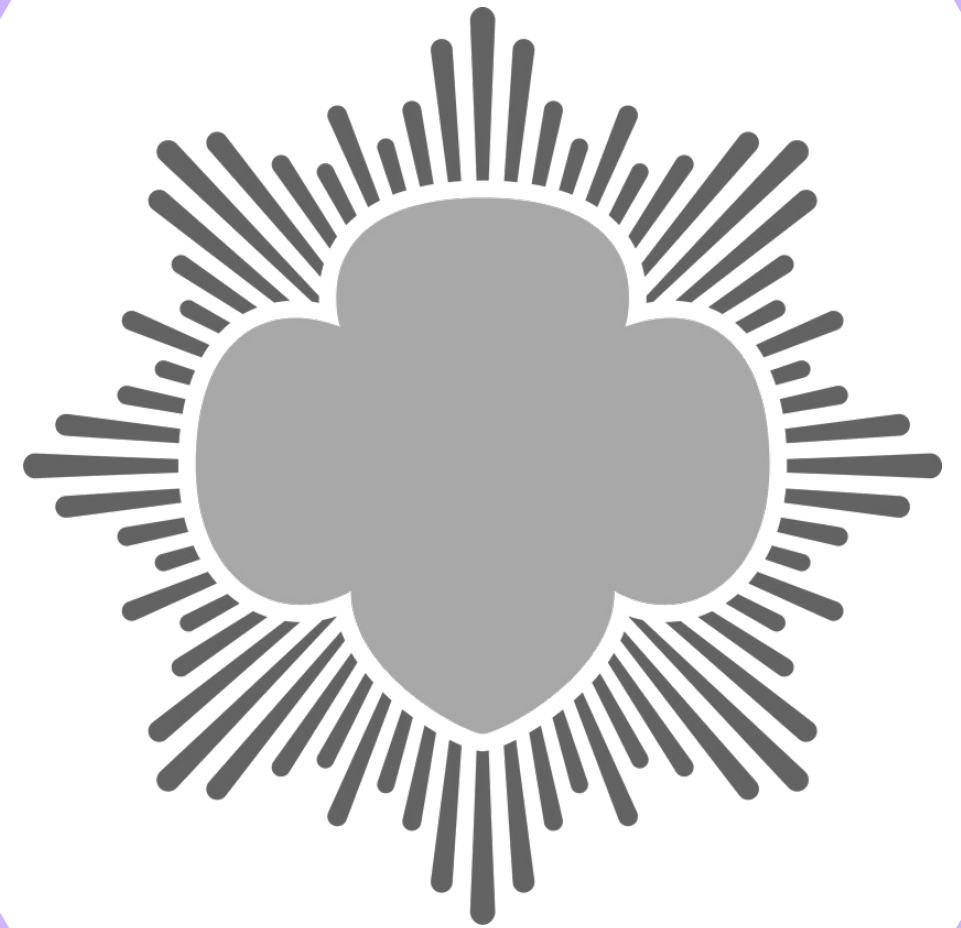
LAUREL LAKE PRESERVE RESTORATION

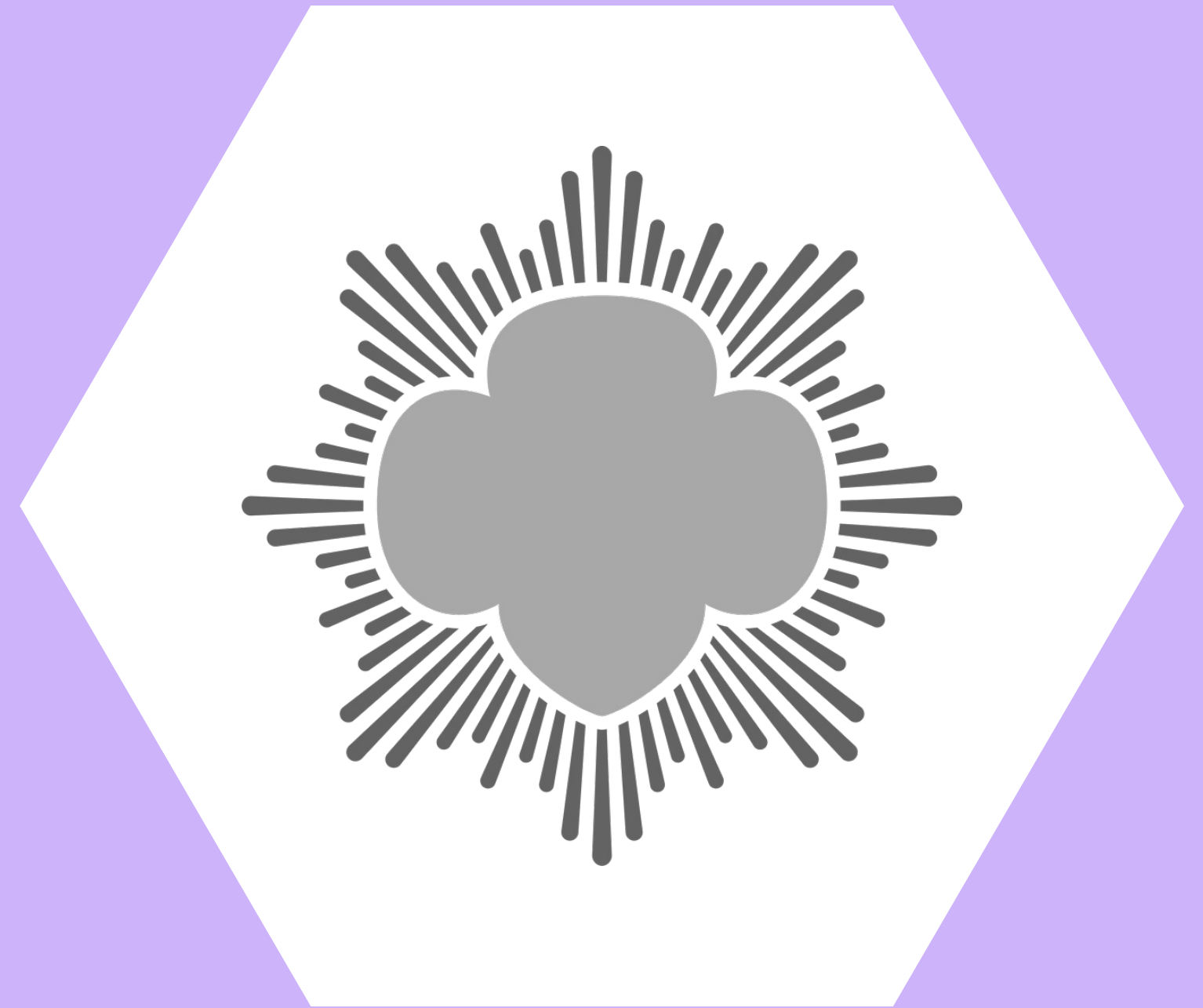

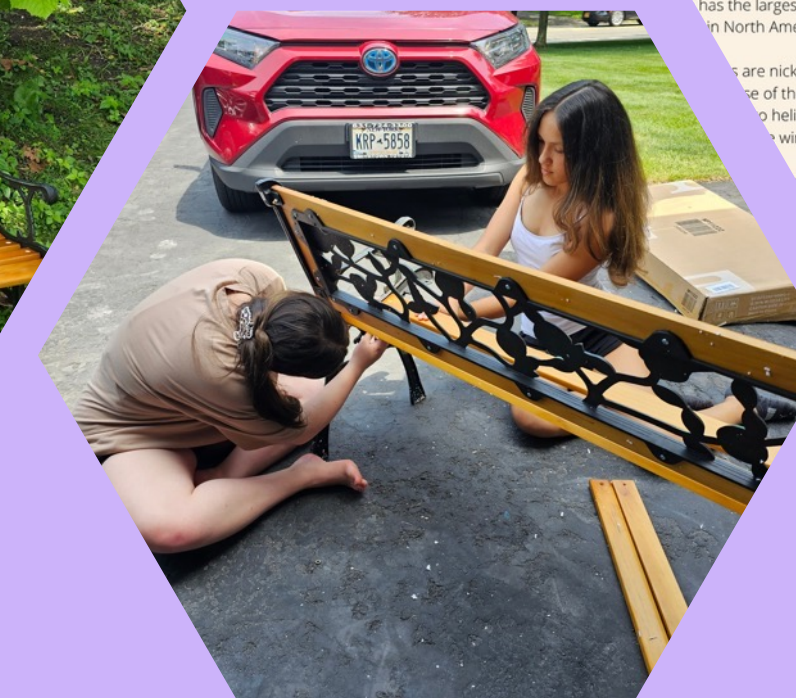

Per the New York Times, Article Old Syc is estimated to be 350 years old. It is more than 9 feet in diameter and 28 feet or more in circumference. It was around more than 100 years before the signing of the Declaration of Independence. Old Long Island shares that Old Syc was part of the Big Tree Farm, which was built for James Norman Hill. He was the son of James Hill, one of the biggest railroad tycoons in the country. James and his wife were prominent horticulturists. Today the tree is part of AHRC Nassau's Thomas S. Gulotta Wheatley Farms & Arts Center. Join us in celebrating Old Syc with our Hug a Tree campaign and Hug a tree today!

The Thomas S. Gulotta Wheatley Farms & Arts Center welcomes people of all abilities to connect with nature and with the people around them. 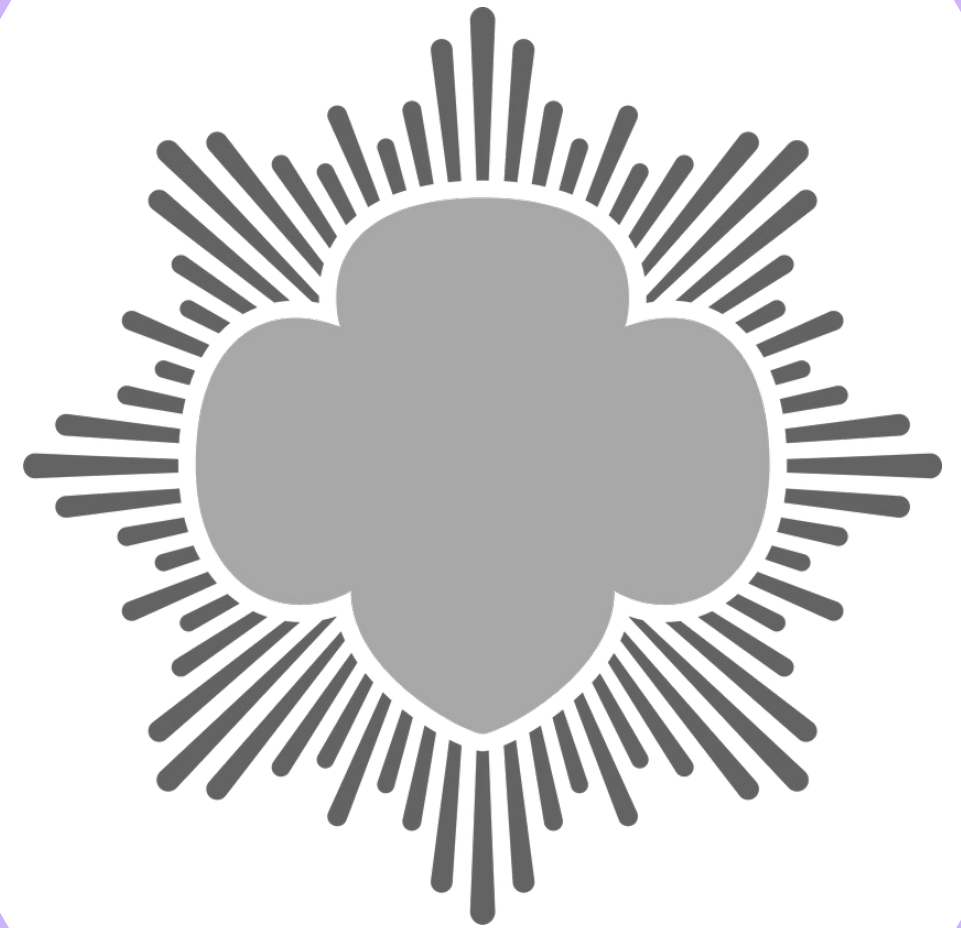
PROMOTING LOVE OF MUSIC IN ELEMENTARY STUDENTS

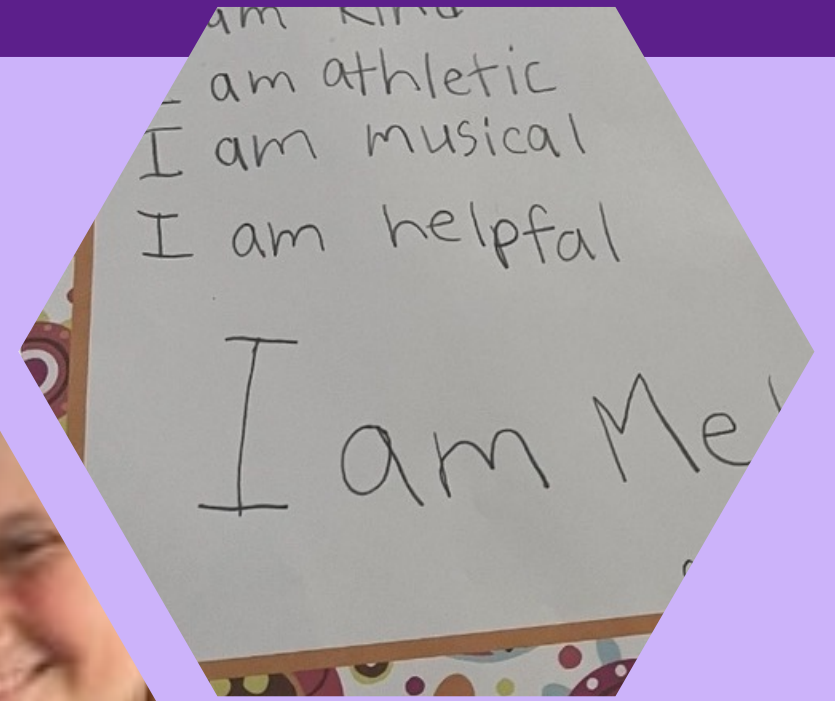
