FIRST AID & SAFETY

American Red Cross Programs: Daisy & Brownie Leaders are required to take Adult CPR, Child/Infant CPR, and First Aid. These three sessions are collectively referred to as *Community First Aid*. Junior, Cadette and Senior Leaders are required to take Adult CPR and First Aid. These two sessions are collectively referred to as *Standard First Aid*. CPR requires annual recertification. First Aid requires three year recertification.

To attend Community First Aid: Choose your course number and plan to attend all three sessions or, for full day sessions, stay the entire day. Cost for this course is \$50 FAN / \$60 Non-FAN / \$72 Not Registered.

To attend Standard First Aid: Choose your course number and plan to attend the sessions on Adult CPR and First Aid. Cost for this course is \$45 FAN / \$55 Non-FAN / \$65 Not Registered.

To attend CPR for both Adult and Child/Infant: Choose your course number and attend the appropriate sessions. Cost for this course is \$45 FAN / \$55 Non-FAN / \$65 Not Registered.
