

Getaway Weekend Procedures - Camp Edey

Please read over before attending your Getaway Weekend. Questions? camp@gssc.us

Check in Procedures:

- Friday Eve: Arrive between 5pm & 6:45pm
- Park in the main parking lot.
- Once ALL your girls/adults have arrived:
- Co-leader stays with group, other leader goes to “Welcome Center” to check in.
- Bring updated roster if it has changed; be sure to include all adults and girls.
- You will be given your site assignment, schedule, map & other important info. You may proceed to your site using the cart assigned to your site (located by the Equipment building). Please return your cart as soon as you unload so others can use it.
- Settle in and proceed to the Juliette Low Friendship Center for dinner- served between 6pm and 7:15pm. Don’t forget your flashlight.
- After dinner, return to your site, take a short hike and get familiarized. Play games or do your own activity.
- Camp fires at 8:30pm at the main fire circle don’t forget your song booklets. Please be on time, if it rains proceed to the JLFC.
- If you have questions, contact a Camp Ambassador at the cabin 472-1371 or by walkie talkie.

Equipment List:

- Sleeping bag (no slumber bags)
- Ground cloth (sheet of plastic, shower curtain or plastic tablecloth)
- First Aid Kit
- Backpack or tote (no wheels) should be packed in heavy duty plastic in case of rain. Please pack clothes in plastic ziplocks.
- Raincoat with hood and boots
- Flashlight w/extra batteries
- Toiletries – soap in container, brush/comb, toothbrush/paste, face cloth, small hand towel, and sanitary supplies if needed.
- Hat
- Jacket (light or heavy)
- 2 pairs underwear
- 2 pairs socks
- Sweatshirt and sweatpants to sleep in (NO PJ’s)
- Sturdy shoes or sneakers (no sandals, slip-ons, flip flops, etc)
- 1 or 2 pairs pants/jeans/shorts
- 2 shirts
- 1 sweater
- Clearly mark all equipment with name

Site Procedures:

- No alcoholic beverages, including beer, wine, wine coolers or illegal drugs are permitted. Violators will be asked to leave.
- Smoking in designated areas only. Please see Camp Ambassador for designated area.
- No pets are permitted in camp.
- Do not deface trees and do not pick, cut or remove any bushes, flowers or trees from camp.
- Accidents that happen during your stay must be reported in writing to the Camp Ambassador (an accident report is available from the Camp Ambassador and must be filled out before leaving camp).
- Please observe good conservation practices.

Also:

- All cars must be parked in the main parking lot only. **No cars** will be permitted to drive to the site. One wagon per site will be issued to transport equipment. No one is to ride in the wagons.
- Electricity in the units is intended to provide kitchen shelter lighting. *No electrical appliances may be used.*
- One test of good camping is how the campsite is left. Please leave the site in better condition than it was when you arrived. If you leave early, please make sure you inform the Camp Ambassador.
- Garbage goes in the large dumpster behind the Welcome Center at Camp Edey. Sanitary napkins, tampons, paper towels, etc. are to be disposed of in the garbage, not down the toilet. Please be sure to caution children about this. Please bring home recyclables.
- The Girl Scouts of Suffolk County is not responsible for any personal articles lost or stolen on Camp property.
- Safe guard against insect bites. Please note: The Board of Health recommends insect repellent that contains the chemical DEET to prevent insect bites. Everyone should check themselves for insect bites throughout their stay. Stay on the paths and wear long pants when possible.
