- 6. Not bully or abuse (hit, slap, spit, or facilitate any other unwanted touch) my Girl Scout sisters or volunteers. I understand that violence will not be tolerated, and my parents/caregivers will be notified, as well as the parents/caregivers of any girls involved.
- 7. Remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine. I will respect the ideas and thoughts of others.

If I do not abide by the Girl Scout Promise and Law and the expectations listed above, my troop leadership may:

- 1. Ask me to adjust my behavior to be in alignment with the expectations I have agreed to.
- 2. Remove me from the activity to review expectations and discuss steps to correct my behavior.
- 3. Request my parent/caregiver to assist with resolving the issue.
- 4. Request my parent/caregiver to attend future meetings and trips.
- 5. Seek council assistance regarding my behavior and may recommend an alternate activity for me.
