I understand that my attitude and behavior are important to my success and the success of others in my troop.

I will:

1. Follow the principles of the *Girl Scout Promise and Law* as listed in this *Code of Conduct*.
2. Follow the rules that are made to protect others and myself and to help make sure program activities are safe, fun, and successful.
3. Treat other people, myself, property, and equipment with respect.
4. Be considerate of the feelings of others.
5. Be respectful of my Girl Scout co-leaders. I will treat them with respect while under their supervision, ask questions calmly, and appropriately express my opinions and concerns.
6. Not bully or abuse (hit, slap, spit, or facilitate any other unwanted touch) my Girl Scout sisters or volunteers. I understand that violence will not be tolerated, and my parents/caregivers will be notified, as well as the parents/caregivers of any girls involved.
7. Remember that others have ideas and thoughts, which may be different from mine, and that their ideas and thoughts are just as important as mine. I will respect the ideas and thoughts of others.

If I do not abide by the Girl Scout Promise and Law and the expectations listed above, my troop leadership may:

1. Ask me to adjust my behavior to be in alignment with the expectations I have agreed to.
2. Remove me from the activity to review expectations and discuss steps to correct my behavior.
3. Request my parent/caregiver to assist with resolving the issue.
4. Request my parent/caregiver to attend future meetings and trips.
5. Seek council assistance regarding my behavior and may recommend an alternate activity for me.

I agree to accept the *Girl Scout Promise and Law* and display appropriate conduct at all times.
